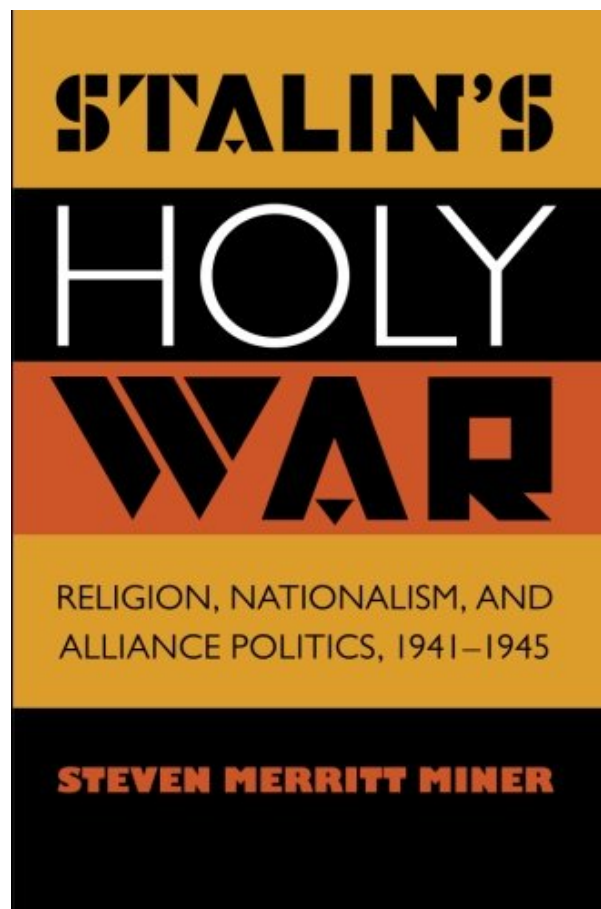
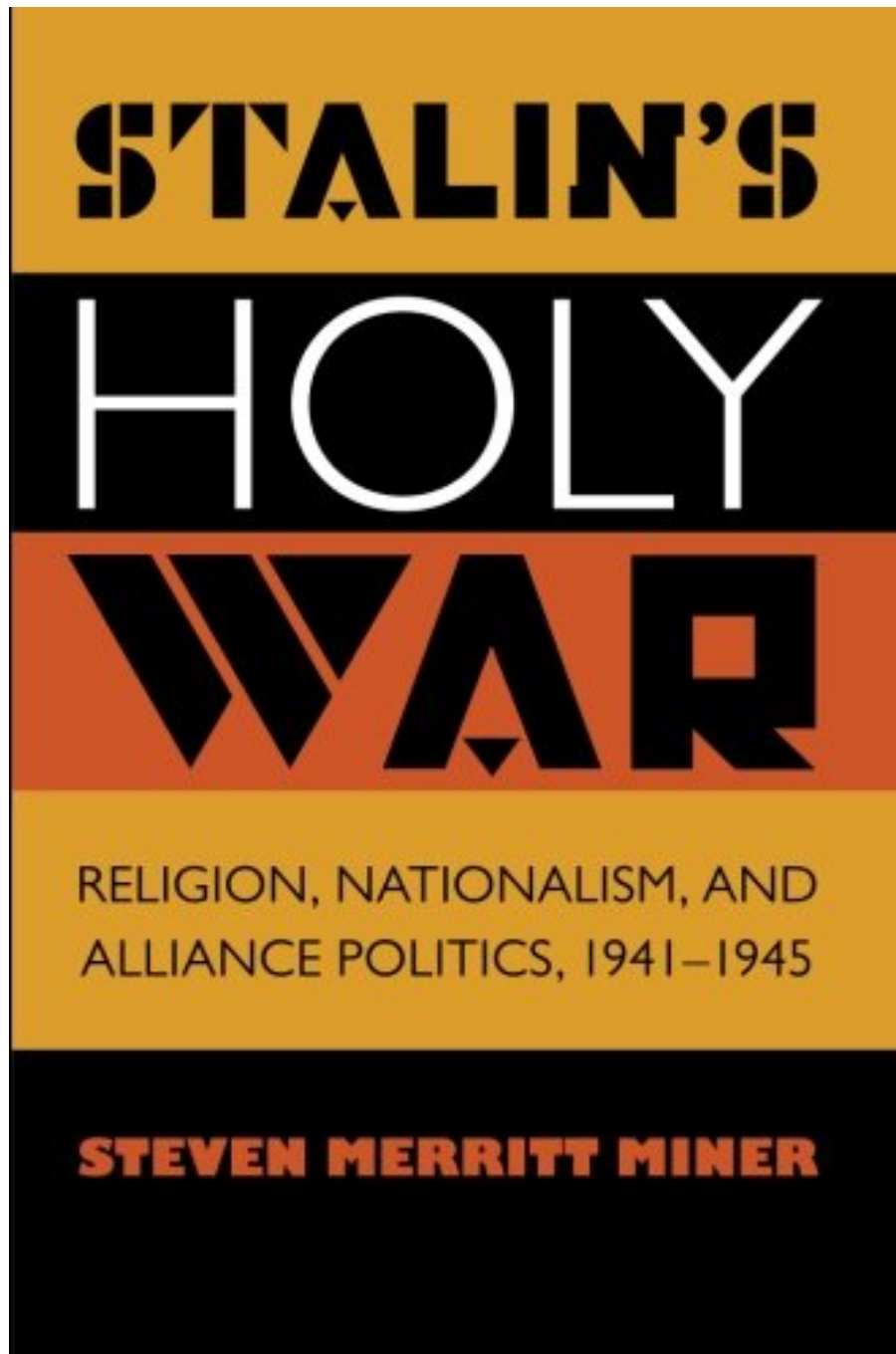

In his conclusion, Miner explores how Stalin's religious policy helped shape the postwar history of the USSR.
